

## RESOLUTION NO. 2025136

RE: AMENDING THE 2025 ADOPTED COUNTY BUDGET AS  
IT PERTAINS TO THE STOP-DWI PROGRAM

Legislators FAUST, POLASEK, and GORMAN offer the following and move its adoption:

WHEREAS, the STOP-DWI Coordinator has advised that the New York State STOP DWI Foundation (“NYS STOP DWI Foundation”) has awarded Dutchess County an increase in the STOP-DWI High Visibility Engagement Campaign (f/k/a Crackdown) Grant for the grant period of October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the original amount of the grant funding was \$35,000, and NYS STOP DWI Foundation by letter dated July 15, 2025, has indicated that the grant funding shall increase by \$6,000, thereby making the total grant funding for the STOP DWI High Visibility Engagement Campaign in the amount of \$41,000, and

WHEREAS, the intent of this STOP DWI Campaign is to revitalize and enhance the visibility of the STOP-DWI Program through multi-agency coordinated impaired driving checkpoints and saturation patrols targeting identified statewide crackdown weekends and/or holidays, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the 2025 Adopted County Budget to provide for the receipt and expenditure of these grant funds, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or her designee is authorized to execute any grant agreements as deemed necessary, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Finance is authorized, empowered and directed to amend the 2025 Adopted County Budget as follows:
