RESOLUTION NO. 2025187

RE: AMENDING THE 2025 ADOPTED COUNTY BUDGET TO FUND A COUNTY-OWNED CENTRAL DUTCHESS PUMP STATION WATER STORAGE TANK PROJECT AS IT PERTAINS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT AND THE WATER & WASTEWATER AUTHORITY

Legislators D'AQUANNI, POLASEK, and GORMAN offer the following and move its adoption:

WHEREAS, the County through the Department of Planning & Development (hereinafter "Planning") and the Water and Wastewater Authority (hereinafter the "DCWWA") are partnering to construct a Central Dutchess Pump Station Water Storage Tank (hereinafter the "Project"), and

WHEREAS, Planning advises that the Project, which is included in the 2025-2029 Capital Plan, entails the construction of a 1,000,000- to 3,000,000-gallon water storage tank between the Overocker Road Meter and the Central Dutchess Transmission Line, and

WHEREAS, this Project will add fire protection, resiliency, and enhance the ability to serve additional residential, commercial and industrial customers, and

WHEREAS, Planning and DCWWA request \$500,000 to cover due diligence, preliminary engineering and design, and property acquisition, and once a property is secured the intent is to submit an additional request for final design and construction, and

WHEREAS, the DCWWA will oversee the Project design, engineering and construction, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for this Legislature to authorize the establishment of a new capital project account which pertains to the aforementioned Project, and

WHEREAS, an appropriation of the fund balance is necessary to provide funding for the aforementioned Project, and

WHEREAS, Planning and DCWWA are actively pursuing outside funding from state and federal sources, including but not limited to Economic Development Administration, Water Infrastructure Improvement Act and Intermunicipal Grants, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the 2025 Adopted County Budget to provide funds to meet the County's expenses, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Finance is authorized, empowered and directed to amend the 2025 Adopted County Budget and establish the following capital project account as follows:
