WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1330(2) of the Real Property Tax Law, the account and certificate(s) of delinquent school taxes have been received by the Commissioner of Finance, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the account and certificate(s) of delinquent school taxes for the year 2025-2026 as reported to the Commissioner of Finance pursuant to Section 1330(5) of the Real Property Tax Law, be accepted and it is hereby directed that the amount of such delinquent taxes and the amount of delinquent taxes from a prior year which an owner elected to pay in installments as of November 21, 2025, together with seven percent (7%) of the amount in addition thereto, be relevied on the real property on which the same is imposed. When collected, the same shall be considered due and owing to the Commissioner of Finance to reimburse the County for the amount advanced, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay the officer charged by law with the custody of school district monies, the amount of the returned delinquent school taxes in accordance with the provisions of Sections 1330(4) and 1330(5) of the Real Property Tax Law.


