MOTOR EQUIPMENT OPERATOR / SANITATION WORKER II

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

Employees perform routine physical work in connection with the collection and disposal of recyclable materials; employee is responsible for leaving stickers or appropriate notices for residents. Employees in this class are responsible for recycling routes in the city. They differ from Motor Equipment Operator / Sanitation Worker I in that they have more responsibility and exercise judgment in determining compliance with recycling regulations. Specific directions are received from a superior, but employees are responsible for the safe and economical operation of their equipment and assigned tasks.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Operates a one-person truck from right or left hand side of vehicle;
- 2. Picks up and loads recyclable materials;
- 3. As appropriate, fills out and leaves stickers or other notices regarding recycling regulations in recycling containers;
- 4. May operate a truck in connection with the removal of snow, debris, and refuse, and the transportation of stone, sand, asphalt, and other materials and supplies;
- 5. May operate a snow plow, sander, water wagon, fuel service truck, sweeper, and utility vehicles;
- 6. Collects bulky waste items and compostable items;
- 7. Maintains vehicles assigned in a clean condition, including running lights;
- 8. Assists foreman as requested:
- 9. Keeps collection records and prepares reports as required by the Sanitation Supervisor;
- 10. May infrequently operate other types of equipment;
- 11. Does related work as required.

<u>FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:</u>

Good knowledge of the operation of trucks and other automotive equipment; ability to drive garbage collection and recycling trucks; ability to understand and follow simple oral and written directions; mechanical aptitude; dependability; physical endurance; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
