

SENIOR BRIDGE MAINTAINER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

This position involves the performance of a variety of duties in connection with the construction and maintenance of bridges. The work calls for previous experience in the carpentry and masonry fields. Verbal or written instructions regarding the work are received from the Bridge Maintenance Supervisor who checks jobs in process and on completion. Supervision may be exercised over subordinate bridge personnel. This position is subject to pre-employment DOT drug testing and ongoing DOT drug and alcohol testing in accordance with DOT guidelines.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITES:

The following is indicative of the level and types of activities performed by incumbents in this title. It is not meant to be all inclusive and does not preclude a supervisor from assigning activities not listed which could reasonably be expected to be performed by an employee in this title.

- 1. Leads and participates in the construction and repair of bridges, culverts and bridge approaches;
- 2. Constructs wooden forms for concrete work related to bridge maintenance and construction;
- 3. Participates in the pouring of concrete for footings, abutments, docks, etc.;
- 4. Participates in the placing and finishing of concrete;
- 5. Assists in general maintenance work during certain times of the year on the interior of buildings;
- 6. Assists in other carpentry activities such as repairing small buildings or sheds;
- 7. Occasionally assists in highway maintenance and construction projects;
- 8. Participates in snow and ice control activities;
- 9. May assist in highway maintenance and construction projects;
- 10. May be required to operate a gang truck in the transporting of workers and equipment between job sites;
- 11. Assumes the duties of the Bridge Maintenance Supervisor in his/her absence.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

Working knowledge of the common practices, tools, terminology and safety precautions of the carpentry and masonry trade;

Working knowledge of bridge construction and maintenance methods and procedures;

Personal characteristics necessary to perform the duties of the position;

Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Two (2) years of work experience in highway construction and maintenance, one (1) year of which shall have been primarily in bridge construction and maintenance.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Candidates must possess a valid New York State Class B Commercial driver's license at time of application and to maintain position. This license must contain no restrictions other than those relating to personal physical conditions. Such restrictions will be reviewed on a case by case basis for compatibility with job duties and will not be an automatic bar to employment. A copy of the current valid license is required at time of application to be able to be considered for appointment.
- 2. An endorsement for tanker vehicles must be obtained within 6 months of appointment.
- 3. Incumbents must obtain certification in first aid training within six (6) months of appointment. Such certification must remain valid to maintain position.
