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DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

This is a supervisory and administrative position responsible for the operations of the Transit Department. The work is performed under the general supervision of a higher-level supervisor with considerable leeway allowed in the planning and supervising of work activities. General supervision is exercised over subordinate operations employees. This is a safety-sensitive position and is subject to pre-employment DOT drug testing and ongoing DOT drug and alcohol testing.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITES:

The following is indicative of the level and types of activities performed by incumbents in this title. It is not meant to be all inclusive and does not preclude a supervisor from assigning activities not listed which could reasonably be expected to be performed by an employee in this title.

- 1. Develops electronic databases and spreadsheets or other form of electronic or paper source to track and monitor transit-related data;
- 2. Oversees the work of the Transit Operations Assistants;
- 3. Oversees the Operations Department in the absence of Transit Operations Supervisor II;
- 4. Oversees driver pre and post trip forms and check for accuracy and completeness;
- 5. Maintains transit-related files;
- 6. Develops and submit reports;
- 7. Participates in road supervision/Hub ambassador program;
- 8. Assists in NTD sampling program administration and monitoring;
- 9. Conducts training programs and schedule for Bus Driver III and Transit Operations Assistants;
- 10. Monitors telephone messages;
- 11. May responds to customer;
- 12. Monitors bus pass sales;
- 13. Supervises and schedules fare counting;
- 14. Checks transit-related forms for completeness and accuracy;
- 15. May be required to drive a Transit Bus.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES (KSA's):

Thorough knowledge of the principles and practices of the Transit Division; thorough knowledge of accepted safety practices and OSHA standards for the trade; thorough knowledge of the operation and mechanical functions of transit vehicles; good knowledge of state and federal laws and regulations as it pertains to transit operations; ability to plan, supervise and inspect the work of others; ability to communicate, both orally and in writing; ability to follow oral and written instructions; ability to lead and direct the work of others; ability to keep records,; ability to exercise good judgment and to apply proper safety procedures to daily work activities; manual dexterity; good hand and eye coordination; dependability; initiative; resourcefulness; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.



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MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Two (2) years of full-time paid work experience in overseeing the operations of buses or other transportation vehicles which shall have included scheduling and interacting with the public.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Candidates must possess the following:

1. A valid New York State Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Class B with passenger and airbrake endorsement at time of application and to maintain position; and

2. 19A Qualification prior to employment commencing and for duration of employment.
