HYDRANT INSPECTOR

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

This is routine work involving manual checking of fire hydrants to ensure the hydrants are operating correctly. The position also involves simple recordkeeping. Work is performed under general supervision.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Removes hydrant caps, places pipe dope on the threads and replaces caps;
- 2. Turns on hydrant to be sure it is operative and then make sure it is turned off;
- 3. Locates shut-off valve for each hydrant, operates valve, installs riser, if necessary, and cleans debris from valve stem;
- 4. Checks packing on each hydrant and tightens, if necessary;
- 5. Inspects hydrant for any possible leakage;
- 6. Paints hydrant, if needed;
- 7. Maintains a maintenance log for each hydrant checked, and makes a report to the Town of any maintenance needs;
- 8. Locates and operates water main shut-off valves, if there is ample time;
- 9. Does related work as required.

<u>FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS</u>:

Working knowledge of how fire hydrants operate; working knowledge of business arithmetic and English; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
