SUPERINTENDENT OF STREETS

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

This position is responsible for the overall repair and maintenance of streets, sidewalks and related facilities for a municipality. The incumbent is also responsible for all snow and ice control activities. The work is performed under the general direction of the mayor, municipal board, or other administrative staff or body. Supervision is exercised over subordinate staff.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Oversees street construction and maintenance activities;
- 2. Directs cleaning, flushing and oiling of streets;
- 3. Supervises the operation and maintenance of all equipment;
- 4. Directs ice and snow removal activities;
- 5. Does related work as required.

<u>FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:</u>

Thorough knowledge of street construction and maintenance practices; good knowledge of the principles underlying the management of a street maintenance force; ability to plan and supervise the work of others; good judgment; tact; initiative and resourcefulness; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and:

EITHER: (A) Graduation from a New York State registered or regionally accredited college or university with a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering and one (1) year of full-

time paid work experience in planning and supervising street construction;

OR: (B) Four (4) years of progressively responsible full-time paid work experience in street construction and maintenance activities, two (2) years of which were in a supervisory capacity;

An equivalent combination of education, training and experience in (A) and (B)

above.
