CHAPLAIN

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

This is a responsible position providing for spiritual and moral guidance and assistance to members of a religious faith or those desiring such assistance. This position is normally located in a County institution, i.e., the Jail and Infirmary.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Conducts religious services of a particular faith or sect;
- 2. Counsels individuals on spiritual and moral matters when requested;
- 3. May be on call in case of emergency to conduct services or counsel;
- 4. May console individuals in case of death, accident or sickness;
- 5. Does related work as required.

<u>FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:</u>

Thorough knowledge of the principles and practices of a religious faith; ability to communicate both orally and in writing with individuals from all areas of society; sensitivity; tact; good judgement; integrity; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Individual must be qualified representatives of a specific religious sect.
