TRUCK DRIVER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

An employee in this class performs routine manual duties in connection with the operation of a tractor trailer to drive sludge from the water treatment plant to a sludge disposal site. The operator is responsible for the safe and economical operation of this vehicle.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Operates a truck in connection with the delivery of sludge from the water treatment plant to a sludge disposal site;
- 2. Performs light maintenance of sludge truck and trailer;
- 3. Performs cleaning and preventative maintenance on equipment;
- 4. Performs breakdown and maintenance of equipment;
- 5. Does related work as required.

<u>FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS</u>:

Knowledge of the operation of trucks and other automotive equipment in order to operate in safe and economic manner;

Knowledge of basic diesel truck maintenance and repair;

Ability to perform all duties in a safe and appropriate manner, in compliance with OSHA, DOL, DMV and department regulations;

Ability to understand and follow simple oral and written directions;

Mechanical aptitude;

Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

None are required.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:

Candidates must possess a valid New York State Class A Commercial Driver's license at the time of appointment and to maintain position.
