SNOW AND ICE CONTROL INSPECTOR

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

The work involves responsibility for making occasional winter season inspections and observations of the county highway system and relaying this information to the Department of Public Works Communications Center. An employee in this class will be required to travel over county highways during inclement weather while making inspections. The work is performed under general supervision, with the employee receiving specific directions concerning work assignments. Supervision of the work of others is not a normal function of this position.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Patrols and inspects county highways during and after storms;
- 2. Makes visual observations of highway travel conditions and related drainage conditions;
- 3. Makes visual observations of atmospheric and surface weather conditions;
- 4. Reports on traffic movements, traffic accidents and the effectiveness of prior snow and ice control measures;
- 5. Prepares reports of activities;
- 6. Does related work as required.

<u>FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:</u>

Working knowledge of county highway system, route numbers and route names; ability to observe, analyze and report on road and weather conditions; ability to understand and follow oral and written directions; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

No minimum qualifications.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT FOR APPOINTMENT:

Possession of a New York State Motor Vehicle Operator's License.
