GROUNDSKEEPER / CLEANER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

This is routine work involving the maintenance of grounds and related equipment and building cleaning. Work is performed under general supervision for assignments which follow a well-established routine. Although it is not normally a function of the class, supervision may be exercised over seasonal or temporary employees.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Mows, rakes and cuts grass;
- 2. Cleans grounds of refuse, debris, and similar materials;
- 3. Maintains lawns and grounds;
- 4. Levels, grades, and removes stones;
- 5. Participates in snow and ice control activities;
- 6. Spreads sand and salt;
- 7. Performs groundskeeping activities such as seeding, fertilization, and watering;
- 8. Transplants seedlings, plants and cares for trees and shrubs; including clipping and pruning;
- 9. Maintains equipment used in grounds maintenance;
- 10. Gathers and disposes of refuse;
- 11. Drives motor equipment as required for grounds maintenance and related tasks;
- 12. Dusts chairs, tables, desks, and other furniture;
- 13. Washes windows, walls, woodwork, water closets, tubs, bowls, and chalk boards;
- 14. Changes light bulbs;
- 15. Sweeps, mops, washes, strips, waxes and oils floors;
- 16. Cleans and polishes furniture and brass;
- 17. May occasionally maintain watch over buildings;
- 18. May assist in maintenance of driveways;
- 19. May perform minor maintenance tasks of an unskilled nature;
- 20. May operate machinery such as sign makers:
- 21. Does related work as required.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Working knowledge of grounds maintenance activities; willingness to work outdoors in all weather conditions; willingness to perform routine manual work; ability to acquire knowledge of routine cleaning operations, materials and equipment; ability to understand and follow simple oral and written instructions; mechanical aptitude; thoroughness; punctuality; cleanliness; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

No minimum qualifications required.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:

Possession of a valid New York State Motor Vehicle Operator's license at time of appointment.
